PSE Summit 2017

India's march towards global leadership demands PSEs to attain scale, be globally competitive and emerge as champions. Today PSEs are fraught with issues relating to governance, autonomy, multiple authorities, conflicting expectations of different stakeholders, competing with private sector without corresponding flexibility of operation. There is a need for better collaboration to unlock value, leading to the creation of a vibrant ecosystem of shared resources amongst them.

Indian PSEs operate in diverse fields. Their roles and responsibilities have undergone a paradigm shift. They have been forbearers of investment and play a vital role in making the country's development more inclusive. To extend their reach requires them to integrate better with global supply chains leveraging their strengths more effectively.

To address these concerns it is imperative to discuss issues between PSEs and different stakeholders. CII PSE Council, an apex forum of CEOs from Central Public Sector Enterprises, is planning to have a **PSE Summit : Making PSEs Future Ready- Opportunities and Challenges** on 19 Dec'17 at Hotel Lalit in New Delhi. The initiative would analyze the situation through the following prisms:

- Policy environment to identify accelerators for development
- Making PSEs globally competitive
- PSEs role in Make in India for deepening its impact

The Council aims to bring together policy makers, global experts on governance, strategy and management on a common platform to decide on the contours of a vibrant ecosystem. The objective is to unshackle the management of PSEs to attain increased efficiencies, optimize operations to capitalize on the opportunities that lay ahead. Based on the deliberations an implementation framework would evolve to be pursued with the stakeholders by the Council as its Advocacy agenda.
